MON 7 A Day of Discovery in Istanbul

After breakfast, we set out on a full-day exploration of Istanbul's most captivating landmarks, where ancient history and vibrant culture intertwine.

Admire the awe-inspiring Hagia Sophia, a masterpiece of Byzantine architecture. Originally built by Emperor Justinian in 537 AD, this iconic structure has served as a cathedral, mosque, and now a museum, standing as a symbol of Istanbul's rich and diverse heritage.

Step into history at the **Byzantine Hippodrome**, once the grand stage for chariot races and imperial ceremonies. Here, we admire impressive relics, including the striking 3,500-year-old red granite obelisk, originally from Egypt and erected here in 390 AD.

The Ottoman era gifted Istanbul with remarkable architectural wonders, and today, we explore two of its most magnificent creations. We visit the Topkapi Palace, the opulent former residence of Ottoman sultans, where exquisite courtyards and priceless treasures offer glimpses into royal life. Then, we marvel at the Blue Mosque, renowned for its six minarets and stunning blue Iznik tiles, a true jewel of Istanbul's skyline.

Our day concludes with an immersive experience at the Grand Bazaar, one of the world's oldest and most vibrant marketplaces. With its maze of bustling alleys, colourful textiles, handcrafted treasures, and aromatic spices, this legendary bazaar invites us to explore, shop, and embrace the lively spirit of Istanbul.

After a day rich in discovery, we return to our hotel to unwind. The evening is at your leisure, with dinner at your own arrangements.

An unforgettable day in the heart of Istanbul!



Istanbul – Gallipoli – Çanakkale TUE 8 This morning, we depart Istanbul and travel to Gallipoli, a site of profound historical significance, especially for Australians and New Zealanders.

Here, we visit the battlefields and memorials of the Gallipoli Campaign, reflecting on the courage and sacrifice of those who fought here during World War I. Key sites include:

- **Anzac Cove** the landing site of ANZAC troops in April 1915.
- **Lone Pine Cemetery** a solemn tribute to fallen Australian soldiers.
- Johnston's Jolly preserved Turkish and Allied trenches and tunnels.
- **The Nek** site of one of the campaign's most tragic charges.
- Chunuk Bair New Zealand Memorial commemorating the role of New Zealand forces.

After a lunch stop, we continue exploring before heading to Çanakkale, where we check into our hotel for the night.

This evening, we gather for dinner at a local restaurant, reflecting on a deeply moving day of history and remembrance.

WED 9 Canakkale – Troy – Assos – Kuşadası (B) (D) Today, we travel to Kuşadası, our home for the next two nights, with stops at some of Turkey's most legendary sites.

This morning, we journey to the legendary city of Troy, an archaeological site dating back 5,000 years. Here, we explore the ruins of this ancient city and see the reconstruction of the fabled Wooden Horse, a symbol of the Trojan War and one of mythology's most famous tales.

Next, we travel to Assos, a picturesque coastal town known for its stunning beaches, charming village atmosphere, and deep historical roots. We take in the breathtaking views from the Temple of Athena, which overlooks the Aegean Sea and the Greek island of Lesbos. At the ancient harbour, enjoy some free time to wander the scenic streets, soak in the local culture, or relax by the water.

Continuing south, we make our way to Kuşadası, a vibrant seaside town and our home for the next two nights. Upon arrival, we check into our hotel and take time to refresh and unwind before gathering for a delightful dinner at the hotel.



THU 10Exploring Ephesus & SirinceBToday, we step back in time with a full-day exploration of some of
Turkey's most treasured historical and cultural sites.

Our journey begins at the **Temple of Artemis**, once one of the **Seven Wonders of the Ancient World**. Though only fragments remain, this ancient site still holds a fascinating legacy.

Next, we explore the breathtaking **Ancient City of Ephesus**, home to some of the world's best-preserved classical ruins. Wander along marble streets lined with grand theatres, ornate fountains, and iconic landmarks, including the famed **Library of Celsus** and the impressive **Great Theatre**, once a hub of entertainment and public gatherings.

From here, we visit the quaint hillside village of **Şirince**, renowned for its olive oil, fruit, and local wine production. With its cobblestone streets and charming boutiques, this former Greek village offers a delightful glimpse into local life.

We then experience the centuries-old tradition of **Turkish carpet weaving** with a visit to a carpet village, where skilled artisans demonstrate the intricate craftsmanship behind these handmade masterpieces.

As the day winds down, we enjoy a delicious seafood dinner at a local restaurant, savouring fresh fish and regional specialties before returning to **Kuşadası** for the night.

FRI 11 Kuşadası – Pamukkale

This morning, we depart Kuşadası and travel to the breathtaking natural wonder of **Pamukkale**, a UNESCO World Heritage site renowned for its thermal spring waters and striking white travertine terraces. Often referred to as **"Cotton Castle"**, these dazzling formations have been sculpted by mineral-rich waters cascading down the mountainside, creating a truly otherworldly landscape.

We explore the travertine pools before visiting the ancient city of **Hierapolis**, a fascinating archaeological site dating back to the 2nd century BC. Home to Anatolia's largest necropolis, with over 1,200 tombs, Hierapolis also boasts a stunning Sacred Pool, where thermal waters ripple over ancient Roman ruins submerged beneath the surface.

After a day of discovery and relaxation in these rejuvenating thermal waters, we settle in for the evening at our Pamukkale hotel, where we enjoy a delightful dinner and unwind in this serene setting.

SAT 12 Pamukkale – Laodicea – Antalya (B) (D) This morning, we depart Pamukkale and journey towards the stunning resort town of **Antalya**, stopping en route to visit the fascinating ancient city of **Laodicea**.

Once the chief city of the Lycus River Valley, Laodicea ad Lyceum (formerly known as Diospolis, "The City of Zeus") thrived as a prosperous centre with a significant Jewish population and later became one of the earliest Christian communities. Walking through its well-preserved ruins, we gain insight into the city's historical and religious significance.

Continuing our drive, we arrive in **Antalya**, a vibrant coastal city nestled along the **Turkish Riviera**, where we check in to our hotel for a two-night stay.

This afternoon, we explore the **Antalya Archaeological Museum**, one of Turkey's most impressive museums. Spanning 13 exhibition halls and an open-air gallery, the museum houses an extraordinary collection of over 5,000 artifacts, ranging from Neolithic relics to Roman sculptures and Ottoman treasures. The exhibits provide a captivating journey through thousands of years of history, offering a deeper understanding of Turkey's rich cultural heritage. After an insightful day, we return to our hotel to relax before gathering for dinner, surrounded by the charm of this beautiful Mediterranean city.

SUN 13 Exploring Perge & Aspendos

Today, we embark on a full-day tour of two of Turkey's most remarkable ancient sites - **Perge and Aspendos**.

Perge is a city renowned for its well-preserved ruins and stunning mosaics. Often referred to as "Turkey's second Zeugma", Perge was once one of the most prosperous cities of the ancient world. As we explore its colonnaded streets, grand stadium, and impressive baths, we uncover the architectural brilliance of this once-thriving metropolis.

We visit the awe-inspiring **Aspendos**, home to one of the bestpreserved Roman theatres in the world. Built in the 2nd century AD, this grand **amphitheatre**, with a seating capacity of 15,000, still stands as a testament to Roman engineering. Beyond the theatre, we explore the ruins of the **Temple of Apollo** and other ancient structures that tell the story of Aspendos' historical significance. After a day of fascinating discoveries, we return to Antalya, where the evening is free for you to relax or explore the city at your own pace.

Today, we leave the Mediterranean coast behind as we journey through Turkey's central heartland, making our way to the magical landscapes of **Cappadocia**.

Our first stop is the **Sultanhanı Caravanserai**, a remarkable 13th-century Seljuk trading post along the ancient Silk Road. Once a key resting place for merchants and travellers, this grand structure provides a fascinating glimpse into the region's rich commercial history.

We continue to **Konya**, home to the **Mevlana Museum**, also known as the **Green Mausoleum**. This revered site is the spiritual centre of the **Mevlevi Whirling Dervishes**, a Sufi order inspired by the teachings of Jalaluddin Rumi. We visit the **tomb and shrine of Rumi**, where his timeless philosophy of love, unity, and wisdom continues to inspire visitors from around the world.

Arriving in Cappadocia, we check in to our hotel, surrounded by the region's breathtaking rock formations and fairy-tale landscapes. After time to settle in, we enjoy a relaxing dinner, preparing for the incredible experiences ahead in this unique destination.

TUE 15 Exploring the Wonders of Cappadocia (B) This morning, we embark on a journey through Cappadocia's most breathtaking landscapes and ancient villages.

Our first stop is **Pigeon Valley (Guvercinlik Vadisi)**, named for the countless man-made dovecotes carved into the soft volcanic rock. Since ancient times, pigeons played a vital role in the region, providing fertilizer for the infertile soil and even serving as a source of food. Though no longer essential to daily life, the rock-carved pigeon houses remain a fascinating feature of the landscape, perched atop rock pillars and hidden within ancient cave dwellings.


Next, we explore **Red Valley**, one of Cappadocia's most scenic and photogenic landscapes. Known for its stunning reddishpink rock formations, the valley transforms into a breathtaking sight at sunset. As we walk along its winding trails, we discover hidden cave churches carved into the rock, each with its own unique history and charm.

Continuing our journey, we visit **Çavuşin Village**, one of the oldest settlements in Cappadocia. This charming troglodyte village is famous for its cave houses and rock-hewn dwellings, offering a glimpse into the region's ancient way of life.

Our final stop takes us to **Avanos**, a town famous for its pottery-making tradition that dates back thousands of years. The **Kızılırmak River (Halys)**, Turkey's longest river, provides the rich red clay used by artisans to craft beautiful ceramics. Here, we witness the traditional pottery-making process and have the chance to admire (or even try) this time-honoured craft.

After a day of exploration, we return to our hotel for an evening at leisure to relax or continue discovering Cappadocia at your own pace.





WED 16 Cappadocia – Istanbul

Our final morning in Cappadocia begins with a journey through its breathtaking lunar-like landscape, where ancient history and natural wonders blend seamlessly.

We start at the Göreme Open-Air Museum, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Cappadocia's most important historical and cultural landmarks. This open-air complex is home to some of the region's best-preserved rock-cut churches, adorned with stunning Byzantine frescoes that have survived for centuries.

Next, we explore Cappadocia's iconic fairy chimneys, towering rock formations sculpted by nature over millions of years. As we admire these surreal landscapes, we witness how the rocky topography transforms under the shifting light - glowing red and purple at sunset and shimmering softly under the moonlight.

Before concluding our Cappadocia adventure, we descend into one of the region's fascinating underground cities, a network of multilevel tunnels and chambers that once served as hidden refuges for ancient civilizations. These subterranean dwellings, complete with living quarters, storage rooms, and even chapels, offer an incredible insight into the ingenuity of early settlers.

Later, we transfer to Kayseri Airport for our flight to Istanbul. Upon arrival, we check in to our hotel and settle in for the evening, with time to relax at leisure or explore the city at your own pace.
