

We return to Hiroshima for lunch, after which we visit the **Peace Memorial Park and Museum**, a place dedicated to commemorating the victims of the atomic bombing on August 6, 1945. The park, with its peaceful trees, lawns, and monuments, contrasts sharply with its tragic past as the city's former political and commercial hub. The museum provides a sobering and deeply moving account of the events of that day. For those who may find the museum emotionally overwhelming, exploring the **Peace Memorial Park** at leisure is a meaningful alternative.

To conclude the day, we visit **Orizuru Tower** for panoramic views of Hiroshima and a rare overhead view of the A-Bomb Dome.
