TUE 9 Kapiti - Ohakune

Our adventure begins this morning as we depart from Kapiti, journeying up the scenic Kapiti Coast and and through the picturesque Rangitīkei region. Along the way, we'll pause for a relaxing lunch break (own cost) before continuing north toward the charming mountain village of **Ohakune** - our base for the next two nights.

This evening, we gather for a welcome dinner at our accommodation, setting the stage for the incredible experiences ahead.

WED 10 Forgotten World Adventure

Today, we embark on an unforgettable journey through the **Forgotten World**, one of New Zealand's most breathtaking North Island destinations. As we explore this hidden gem, we uncover the stories of resilient pioneers and remote communities, all set against a backdrop of ever-changing landscapes. From **Taumarunui**, we board a shuttle bus to **Lauren's Lavender Farm**. Nestled alongside the serene **Whanganui River**, this charming haven invites us to breathe in the calming scent of lavender and browse the delightful range of lavender-infused products in the gift shop.

From here, we continue deeper into the Forgotten World, arriving at **Tokirima**, where a delicious lunch and homemade treats await. After refueling, we step aboard our **rail cart**, ready to journey along 40 kilometers of the **Forgotten World Railway**. As we roll down the line, we travel through **10 historic tunnels**, including the longest at an impressive **1.5 kilometres**. The beautifully hand-built brick tunnels, scenic hill country farms, and lush native bush create a truly mesmerising experience.

Our journey concludes in **Okahukura** before returning to **Taumarunui**. From here, we make our way back to **Ohakune**, where we will gather for a well-deserved dinner at our hotel's restaurant, reminiscing about our incredible day in the Forgotten World.

THU 11 Ohakune to Whananui

This morning, we set off for **Piripiki**, where an exhilarating **jetboat adventure** awaits. Travelling 30 kilometres upstream into the heart of the **Whanganui River**, venturing deep into this remote and untouched wilderness.

Upon reaching **Mangapurua Landing**, we embark on a 40-minute walk (each way) through lush native bush, leading us to the iconic **Bridge to Nowhere** - a fascinating remnant of New Zealand's pioneering past, now standing as a symbol of resilience and history.

After taking in the serenity of this secluded location, we return via jetboat and continue our journey along the scenic Whanganui River Road, soaking in the ever-changing landscapes. By late afternoon, we arrive in the charming riverside city of Whanganui, where we settle in for the night.

This evening, we gather for a **special Farewell Dinner** at a local restaurant, reminiscing about our unforgettable adventures and sharing stories from our time together.

FRI 12 Whanganui - Kapiti



Today, we spend a delightful day exploring Whanganui, beginning with a leisurely stroll around **Virginia Lake** and the **Winter Gardens**. The tranquil setting, vibrant floral displays, and serene waters make for a refreshing and picturesque start to our morning.

Next, we step into Whanganui's history with a visit to Durie Hill, home to one of New Zealand's most unique attractions - the **Durie Hill Elevator**. Built in 1919, this remarkable piece of engineering is New Zealand's only earthbound elevator and one of just two in the world. To reach it, we pass through a 205-metre pedestrian tunnel carved into the hillside, before ascending 66 metres to the top, where panoramic views of Whanganui and beyond await.

After soaking in the stunning scenery, we begin our journey south toward home. As our adventure comes to an end, we hope you take with you wonderful memories of your time exploring the Forgotten World, Whanganui River, and beyond.
