


SECRETS OF THE NILE





DAY 1 200CT: HOME - CAIRO (F)

This afternoon you will be collected from your home, arriving at Wellington Airport prior to our flight to Cairo.

DAY 2 210CT : CAIRO (D)

On arrival into Cairo late morning, we are welcomed by our local host and transferred to our hotel for a relax and refresh after our journey from New Zealand. In the afternoon, we board our coach for a city highlights tour, including a visit to the Grand Mosque. This evening we relax and dine together at our hotel.

DAY 3 22OCT : CAIRO - ASWAN (B,AT)

After breakfast today we board our coach for a visit to Memphis, Saqqara before heading to Cairo Airport for our domestic flight to Aswan. On arrival in Aswan we check into the Sofitel legend, Old Cataract Hotel, with time to enjoy the quintessential and famous afternoon tea together. The evening is yours free to explore or just rest and relax.

DAY 4 23OCT : ASWAN (B,L,D)

Today is the start of our Nile Cruise as we transfer to our superior class river cruiser, the 5* Mövenpick MS Darakum, moored on the Nile. Here we just unpack once before we then experience the freedom of a felucca ride around the Aswan Islands and visit a local Nubian family for a cup of tea. This evening we settle in to enjoy dinner & music onboard. Overnight onboard in Aswan



DAY 5 240CT : ASWAN (B,L,D)

Today after breakfast we visit the High Dam and Philae Temple, returning to our ship for lunch before an afternoon visit to the Nubian Museum. The museum is a reminder of what was lost beneath Lake Nasser. Exhibits are beautifully displayed in huge halls, where clearly written explanations take you from 4500 BC through to the present day. This evening we experience the delights of a Nubian show after dinner. Overnight onboard in Aswan.

DAY 6 25OCT : ASWAN – KOM OMBU - EDFU (B,L,D)

This morning we sail the Nile before arriving in Kom Ombo, after lunch we visit the Kom Ombo Temple, one of the Nile Valley's most beautifully sited temples. Unique in Egypt, the temple's twin dedication is reflected in its plan: perfectly symmetrical along the main axis of the temple. Sailing on, we arrive into Edfu and this evening enjoy the Managers Cocktail Party together. Overnight onboard in Edfu.

DAY 7 26OCT : EDFU - LUXOR (B,L,D)

This morning we begin our day with a visit to the Edfu Temple. This Ptolemaic temple, built between 237 and 57 BC, is one of the best-preserved ancient monuments in Egypt. With its roof intact, it is also one of the most atmospheric of ancient buildings. On return we set sail on to Luxor enjoying the scenery via the Esna Lock and enjoy dinner together this evening. Overnight onboard in Luxor

DAY 8 270CT : LUXOR (B,L,D)

After breakfast we have an early start to visit the East Bank. We start with Luxor Temple, largely built by the New Kingdom pharaohs Amenhotep III (1390–1352 BC) and Ramses II (1279–1213 BC). This temple is a strikingly graceful monument in the heart of the modern town. We return to the ship for lunch and refresh, before heading out again mid afternoon to visit Karnak Temple, an extraordinary complex of sanctuaries, kiosks, pylons and obelisks dedicated to the Theban triad but also to the greater glory of pharaohs. The site covers more than two square kilometres, large enough to contain about ten cathedrals. After dinner this evening we enjoy a captivating Belly Dance Show. Overnight onboard in Luxor.



DAY 9 28OCT: LUXOR – QENA – NAG HAMMADI (B,L,D)

This morning we enjoy breakfast and the sights from the Nile as we sail to Qena. After lunch onboard we visit the Dendara Temple. This complex is one of the best preserved in Egypt. On return to the ship we set sail to Nag Hammadi, sailing through two locks and under the Nag Hammadi Bridge. Overnight onboard in Nag Hammadi.

DAY 10 29OCT : NAG HAMMADI – ABYDOS - SOHAG (B,L,D)

Enjoy breakfast during an early morning sail to El Balyana via Abu Homar's bridge & lock day. Later this morning we disembark and visit the Abydos Temple, the holy city of Osiris God of the Dead. Continuing to the main monument of Abydos, The Temple of Seti I, built around 1300 BC by Seti and his son, Ramses II. It is especially notable for its fine reliefs, considered among the best of the New Kingdom. We lunch onboard today as we sail to Sohag, after spending the afternoon relaxing, we regather for dinner and a fabulous Galabaya party, along with Egyptian Wine Tasting. Overnight onboard in Sohag.

DAY 11 30OCT : SOHAG – ASYUT – TELL EL AMARNA (B,L,D)

We set sail while breakfast is served before we arrive at Asyut's lock, passing the lock we continue on to Tell El Amarna. Arriving in Tell El Amarna, once the city of Akhenaten, the Pharaoh known for his revolutionary religion that worshipped Aten we visit the Amarna Visitor Centre to view a presentation on Akhenaten. Back onboard, with time for a refresh, we take part in a traditional cookery lesson before enjoying dinner together this evening. Overnight onboard in Tell El Amarna.

DAY 12 31OCT: TELL EL AMARNA – TUNA el-GABAL – MINYA (B,L,D)

This morning we have an early start with a visit to Tuna el-Gebel, the necropolis of Khmun and continuing on to El Ashmunein to visit its open-air museum, Temple of Thoth, and the Sanctuary of Amun. We return to the ship early afternoon and take lunch, with the rest of the afternoon free to relax, as we set sail to Minya. Dinner this evening is followed by a folkloric show. Overnight onboard in Minya.



DAY 13 01NOV: MINYA – BENI SUEF (B,L,D)

Following breakfast we begin our day with a visit to the rock tombs of Beni Hassan Baqet III, Tomb of Khety, Tomb of Amenemhat and the Tomb of Khnumhotep II. On return to the ship early afternoon, we set sail to Beni Suef. Tonight we take part in a fun filled quiz night together after dinner. Overnight onboard in Beni Suef.

DAY 14 02NOV: BENI SUEF - CAIRO (B,L,D)

This morning we set sail for Cairo with breakfast and lunch onboard before arriving this afternoon in time to visit Coptic Cairo including the Hanging Church, Coptic Museum and Jewish Synagogue. Dinner is onboard tonight and we will be entertained with Takht (middle eastern music).

DAY 15 03NOV : CAIRO (B,L,D)

We have our breakfast onboard this morning before heading off to Giza, where the famous Pyramids stand as monuments to the Pharoahs of Ancient Egypt and the Great Sphinx, which has kept its secrets for centuries. We return for lunch onboard and a refresh before we head out again to explore the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, containing treasures from Egypt's ancient past. This evening no doubt we will regale with our stories, as we share our Farewell Dinner together onboard. Overnight onboard in Cairo.

DAY 16 04NOV: CAIRO – DISEMBARKATION – DUBAI (B, F)

It's time to say goodbye today as we transfer from our river cruise ship to Cairo International Airport for our flight home. This will be a great time to reflect on our amazing journey together and swap our contact details with the new made friends.

Our flight departs Cairo early afternoon and tonight we have an overnight stopover in Dubai, prior to our onwards departure tomorrow morning.

DAY 17 05NOV: DUBAI - HOME (B,F)

This morning we return to Dubai Airport for our flight home, arriving back in Wellington on 6th November, where will be collected for our onwards transfers home.
